Traffic and parking

The YRA is very conscious of the parking constraints at the Bentham Street shops and the recent increase in traffic throughout Yarralumla particularly down Novar and Weston Streets and Hopetoun Circuit.

The potential widening of Dudley Street, growing population in the Molonglo and Weston Creek areas, increased commercial development off Kent Street (Deakin) and the proposed new development of the Canberra Brickworks will only exacerbate the issues.

The YRA has met with TCCS (the ACT Government Department responsible for traffic and parking) to discuss our concerns. We are examining existing data and plan to produce a position paper. Please contact us if you have any specific concerns.

Yarralumla Bay - update

Canberra Girls Grammar School rowing shed

Canberra Girls Grammar School plans to build a new rowing shed and café next to their existing facilities on Yarralumla Bay. The school is targeting the end of 2017 for completion.

YMCA Lease

The YRA continues to seek clarification from the ACT government about their enforcement of the YMCA's lease, which prohibits the YMCA from using the premises as their head office or for non-aquatic recreation related businesses.

Canberra Brickworks Update

The tender for the two short listed proponents will close on January 16, 2017. We expect it will take 2 or 3 months for the ACT government to select a preferred tenderer. The ACT government will then negotiate/fine-tune details with the preferred tenderer. The Community Panel, which includes members of the YRA committee, has already met with the two short listed proponents and will have further opportunities to review and discuss the proposals before the formal announcement of the successful tenderer in mid-2017. This will be followed by opportunity for wider community input when the successful tenderer formulates an Estate Development Plan that will be subject to community consultation. The Estate Development Plan will be the key document for locking in the scope of development. We'll notify members when it is available for review and feedback.
